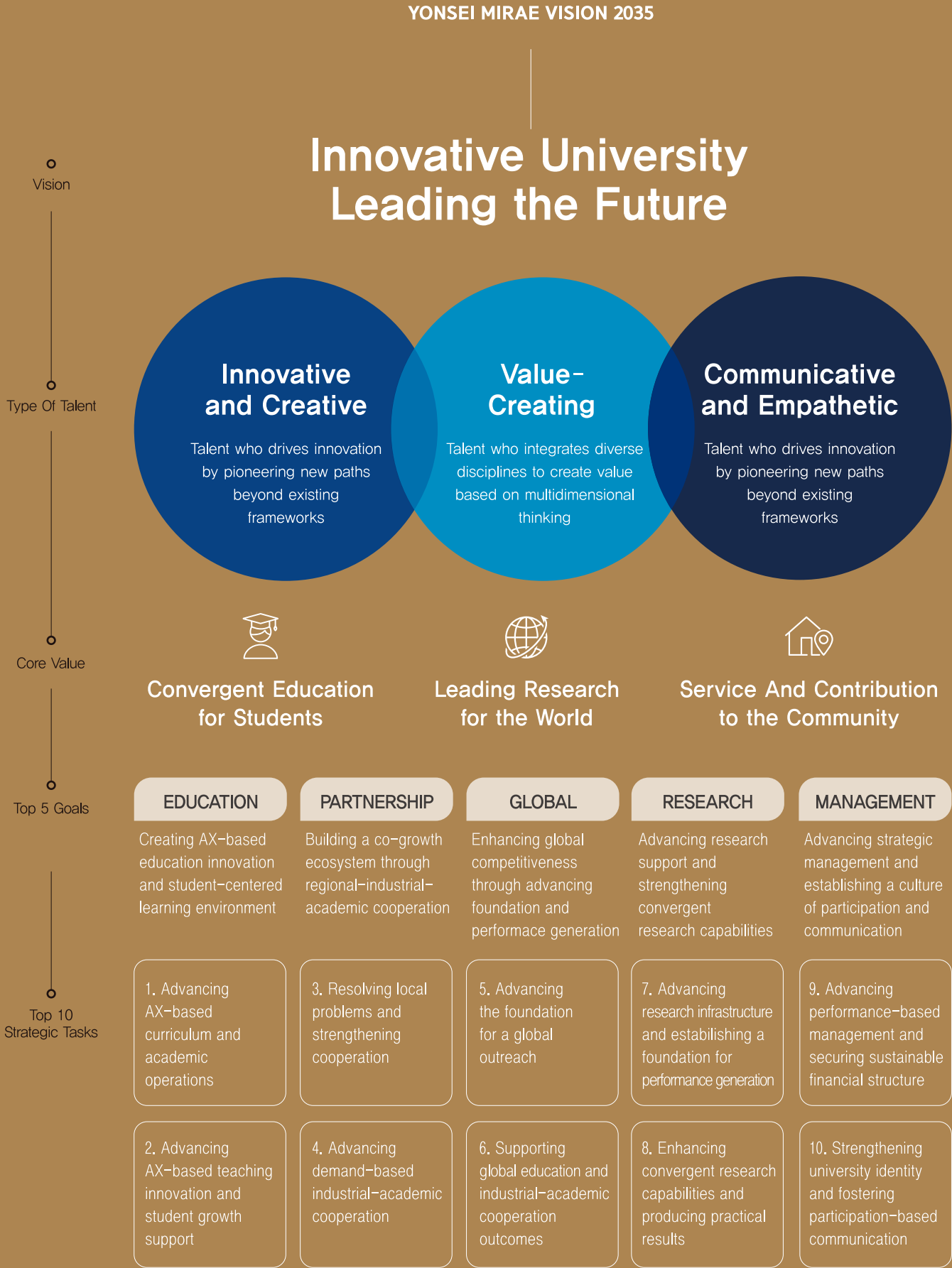

DEA (Division of East Asian Studies)

The East Asia International College, founded in 2008 as a special program to develop professionals for leadership in the 21st-century global era, has grown into a leading center for teaching and research on East Asia. In 2021, it was reorganized as the Division of East Asian Studies (DEA) under the College of Humanities & Social Sciences Convergence. DEA offers undergraduate courses conducted entirely in English. During the first two years, students take foundational courses in the humanities and social sciences, followed by intensive major courses in their third and fourth years. In addition, students study East Asian languages-Chinese, Japanese, or Korean-and actively participate in study abroad opportunities through Yonsei University's exchange programs.

GED (Global Elite Division)

The Global Elite Division (GED) is committed to preparing leaders of tomorrow who will shape the future of a global society. Since its establishment in 2016, GED has offered innovative interdisciplinary programs enriched with diverse opportunities for international engagement. The division offers four undergraduate majors: Cultural Industrial Management, Digital Media Design, Global Industrial Business, and Rehabilitation and Health. Our programs blend rigorous academics with practical learning experiences to equip students for success in their careers and beyond.

International MBA

The International MBA program offers a globally oriented curriculum designed to train professional managers with expertise in global business and strong foreign language skills, with a particular focus on international business as well as cultural and arts management. Global Programs & Exchange: Fostering Student Integration

Exchange Student Program

Exchange students pay tuition to their home university (or the cost is covered by the home university), while application, documentation, and tuition fees are waived at the host university. Admission for one or two semesters is open to students who have completed at least two semesters (or the equivalent) of university-level coursework at an accredited institution outside Korea.

Admission decisions are based on a review of submitted documents, including a recommendation letter, a personal statement, and proof of the required GPA.

Global Village

The Global Village (GV) program is a leadership initiative where Korean and international students live together, learn from cultural differences, and build lasting friendships. To promote deeper understanding of languages and cultures, the GV program provides both formal and informal learning opportunities, including exclusive courses for GV participants, peer mentoring sessions, special events, and a short field trip. Originally offered only in English, the program expanded in 2010 to include Chinese and Japanese. International students in the GV program are eligible for financial aid that covers housing, travel, and living expenses.



Korean Language Courses for International Students

Yonsei University MIRAE Campus offers Korean language courses designed for international students planning to study at a university in Korea. The goal of the program is to equip students with sufficient proficiency to pursue undergraduate or graduate studies. It consists of six levels, each lasting about ten weeks, and requires roughly 18 months to complete all levels. Classes are held four hours a day, five days a week. A high school diploma or its equivalent is the minimum requirement for admission.

Campus Facilities

Dormitories



The MIRAE Housing Complex-comprising Maeji Haksa, Seiyon Haksa, Cheongyeon Haksa, Anderson Haksa, and Judy Haksa-includes ten residence halls. Each dormitory is equipped with computer labs, lounges, study areas, lecture rooms, prayer rooms, music rooms, and laundry facilities. All incoming freshmen are guaranteed on-campus housing. Rooms also feature air-conditioning, refrigerators, and high-speed internet access.



Library



The library holds over 540,000 volumes and provides more than 50 electronic resources-including e-journals, e-books, and academic databases-serving as a core hub for teaching, research, and learning at Yonsei. The six-story building offers general reading rooms, Y-DigiNest (Digital Lounge), creative learning spaces, collection rooms, an information-literacy classroom, and seminar rooms, with 1,306 study seats. Interlibrary loan services extend access to additional resources from other Yonsei libraries-including the Shinchon Central, Underwood Memorial, Shinchon Medical, and Wonju Medical libraries-as well as partner institutions in the KERIS consortium.



Sports Center



Built in 2003, the Yonsei Sports Center offers students a wide range of fitness and recreational facilities, including basketball, volleyball, and squash courts; a gymnasium and fitness club; a rock climbing wall; and an indoor swimming pool with an aqua-health pool and scuba diving pool.



Student Union



The Student Union serves as the hub of student life, featuring a diner, food court, convenience store, small theater, music listening room, and student lounges. It also houses essential services such as the Department of Student Affairs and Services, the MIRAE Human Resources Development Institute, the Career Development Center, the Center for Students with Disabilities, and the Health Care Center. In addition, the building supports independent student organizations, including the Student Association, the Club Association, and the Student Press Union.



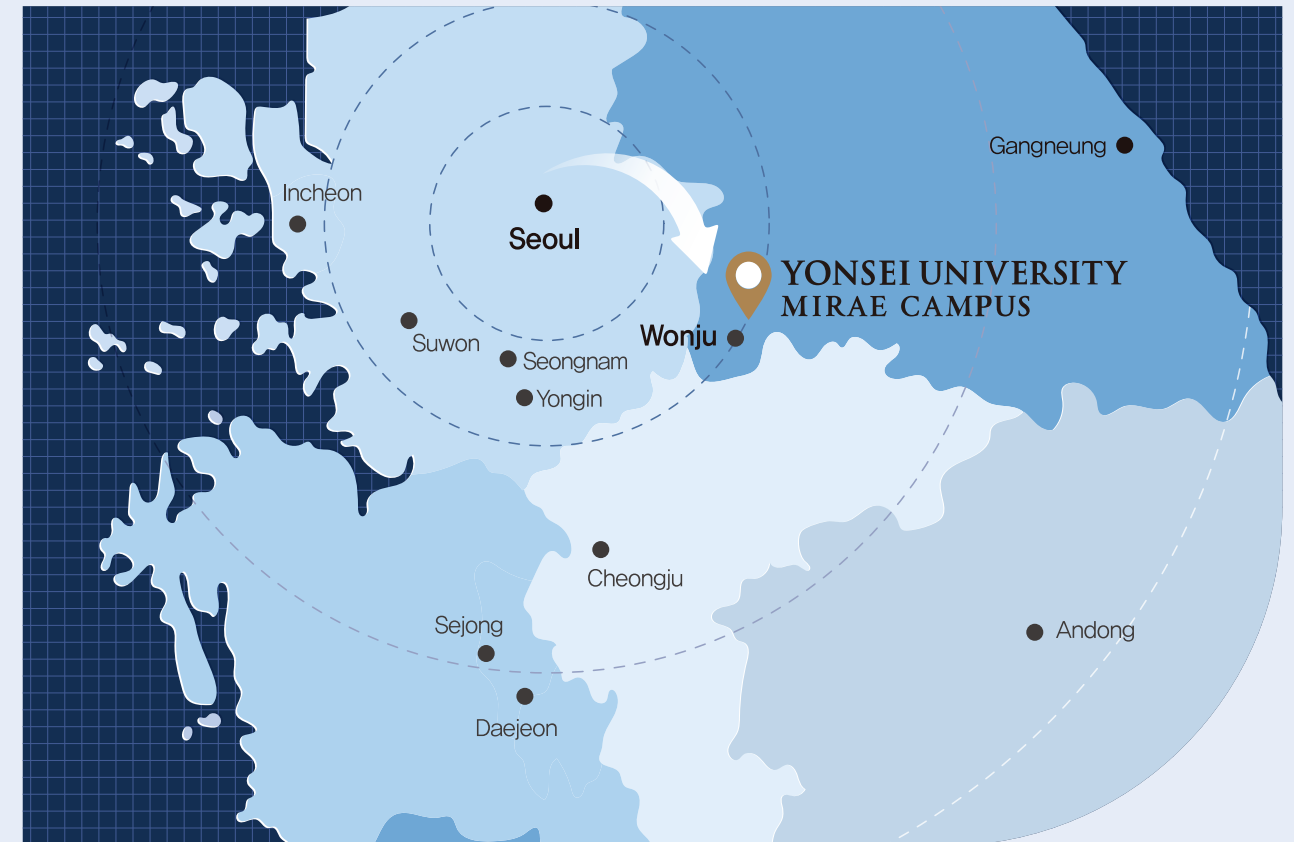
Yonsei Plaza

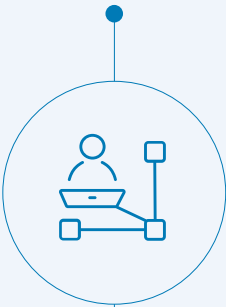
